

**Supporting Documents for Asylum/Withholding claims**

You are filing a claim for asylum or withholding of removal based on claims that you have been persecuted or fear future persecution if you were removed or returned back to your home country.

Your application has been (or will be submitted) and these documents are very important to support your claim. Please do your best to obtain all supporting documents as soon as possible.

- Police reports filed in your home country
- Restraining Orders
- Letters/statements/affidavits of persons (i.e. parents or other relatives, friends, neighbors) who can corroborate details of your claim
- Pictures of any physical injuries to your person
- Pictures of any damage to your property or business
- Newspaper articles that support your claim
- Death certificates of victims close to you or relatives
- Record of any medical or psychological treatment received, due to being a victim in your home country or here in the United States

**Translations**

All documents that you wish to have submitted to the court must be in Translated into English. So please decide if you visit a Notary or Translation company and return your supporting documents translated, OR, if you will pay \$40 in cash for every regular sized page.

All translations must be ready to submit two weeks prior to a scheduled hearing.
