3. \_\_\_\_\_ 2 Passport Photos.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Proof of Legal Permanent Residency status for Applicant (green card)
5. \_\_\_\_\_ Birth Certificate of Applicant w/ Translation if necessary
6. \_\_\_\_\_ Marriage Certificate w/ Translation if necessary
7. \_\_\_\_\_ Divorce Judgment (if applicable)
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Birth Certificate of all children, regardless of age
9. \_\_\_\_\_ Evidence of family ties
10. \_\_\_\_\_ Notarized letters of Reference / Recommendation (about 5 letters is good)
11. \_\_\_\_\_ Income tax returns – 3 most recent years
12. \_\_\_\_\_ Documents proving physical presence. For Example: bank account statements, receipts, letters, birth certificates of children, letters from the church, school records or employment records.
13. \_\_\_\_\_ Evidence of family ties, copies of green card or US passport of family members with status
14. \_\_\_\_\_ Proof that a child of yours is in the army.
15. \_\_\_\_\_ Employer Letter and Evidence of your employment history
16. \_\_\_\_\_ Proof of property owned (if any)
17. \_\_\_\_\_ Business license, if you have your own business.
18. \_\_\_\_\_ Evidence of drug and alcohol rehabilitation (for crimes committed)
19. \_\_\_\_\_ Evidence of hardships your family will face if you are deported.
