- 7. \_\_\_\_Divorce Judgment (if applicable)
- 8. \_\_\_\_\_ Birth Certificate of all children, regardless of age
- 9. \_\_\_\_ Evidence of family ties
- 10. \_\_\_\_\_ Notarized letters of Reference / Recommendation (about 5 letters is good)
- 11. \_\_\_\_\_ Income tax returns 3 most recent years
- 12. \_\_\_\_\_ Documents proving physical presence. For Example: bank account statements, receipts, letters, birth certificates of children, letters from the church, school records or employment records.
- 13. \_\_\_\_\_Evidence of family ties, copies of green card or US passport of family members with status
- 14.\_\_\_\_\_ Proof that a child of yours is in the army.
- 15.\_\_\_\_Employer Letter and Evidence of your employment history
- 16.\_\_\_\_Proof of property owned (if any)
- 17. \_\_\_\_\_ Business license, if you have your own business.
- 18.\_\_\_\_\_Evidence of drug and alcohol rehabilitation (for crimes committed)
- 19.\_\_\_\_\_ Evidence of hardships your family will face if you are deported.
